One of the main objectives of the land use plan in the eastern area is to develop the area around the universities and Wilberforce. Further, the proposed improvements of Bickett Road and US 42 would benefit Central State University and the township for economic development providing jobs to the area and students. If development occurs, it will increase enrollment by providing amenities.

Stewart mentioned a new federal funding source, for transportation in rural areas, acronym TIGERII for US 42 and Bickett Road. Garland added the new conference center at Emery Hall and the legislation introduced by Senator Voinovich and Representative Austria for creation of a new National Park at the Colonel Young House should also be given consideration when considering traffic and development.
